DAY 1, 14 MAY 2025

Arrival, Hotel Check-In, and Welcome Dinner

- **18:55** Arrival at Václav Havel Airport, Prague (flight from Copenhagen with Norwegian at 17:35)
- **19:30** Transfer to Hotel Savoy Prague
- **20:00** Check-in at Hotel Savoy Prague

Situated just a 5-minute walk from the UNESCO-listed Prague Castle, Hotel Savoy is ideally located near some of Prague's most historic landmarks, including the Archbishop's Palace, Schwarzenberg Palace, and the House of Canons (seen in the movie Amadeus).

The monastery's beautiful library, which has featured in films like From Hell and Casino Royale, adds to the charm of this historic setting.

Excursion to Rückl Glassworks and Krivoklát Castle


- **09:00** Departure from Hotel Savoy by bus
- 10:00 11:30 Visit to Rückl Glassworks in Nižbor Rückl Glassworks, a family-run establishment since 1846, is known for its exquisite craftsmanship. The tour offers a behind-the-scenes look at all stages of glass production, including blowing, painting, and cutting. Rückl's famous crystal creations include the Czech Lion film awards and pieces crafted for Hollywood's iconic films.
